

Club General Information

Non-Kits FSC members can not register before August 31, 2010. Ice time is non-transferable. Every attempt will be made to re-schedule sessions that the Kits FSC has cancelled. Pro-rating for late entry is available starting Tuesday, October 5, 2010. There is a \$10 admin fee. The Kits FSC is not responsible for supplying make-up time for sessions missed by the skater. The Kits FSC is not responsible for lost or stolen articles. Unfortunately, the Ice Rinks are a target for thieves, so please keep your gear and property secure. All parents/guardians are 100% responsible for their children while at Kitsilano Arena. Do not leave children unattended.

All Buy-Ons must be paid prior to skating. There will be a Buy-On sign-in book and individual envelopes where you may sign-in and leave your payment.

Session Criteria and Ice Use Policies

Kitsilano FSC has only a limited amount of ice and needs to serve skaters with a wide variety of skills. In order to maximize the enjoyment of the ice for skaters at different skill levels we have divided our ice sessions into classifications. You may skate only on ice for which your classification fits. These classifications are:

Elementary	Holds CanSkate Level 6 Report card or above. No program needed.
Junior	Holds CanSkate Level 6 Report card or above Working elementary or pre-preliminary program
Intermediate	Preliminary FS Test Passed or above
Senior	Full Senior Bronze FS Test Passed or above Juvenile Competitive or above

Skaters who do not yet hold a CanSkate Level 6 Report card are called "Beginners". Due to the large number of different classes of users, and limited ice, there are no sessions for Beginners wishing private learn-to-skate lessons. You should really consider CanSkate as we run three CanSkate sessions per week. We also run three Junior Development sessions per week, and you are welcome to apply for them, but you should realize that Junior Development has admission requirements.

Adults without tests are allowed on Junior or Adult ice only and may skate unsupervised. Adults with recent test levels may skate in the appropriate category.

Skate Canada Coaches

Skate Canada certified coaches and their students are welcome to our open sessions, provided they meet session criteria and adhere to our policies, and provided the session is not full. Students wishing private lessons should book in advance with the coach of their choice. Remember to be on-time to your lessons. See our web-site for our many club coaches as well as freelance coaches.

Ice Etiquette and Right of Way

- All skaters must treat fellow skaters, coaches and Kits FSC Board members with respect.
- Skaters performing their Solo have the first right of way. Please wear the Yellow/Red Performance Sash for identification.
- Skaters in a lesson have the next right of way.
- Skaters may request solo music up to twice/session, unless in a lesson. Please respect the music queue.
- Skaters should avoid skating in the centre of the rink as this impedes on the other skaters' ability to perform their programs.
- Skaters must be aware of other Skaters positions at all times.
- Do not interrupt coaches when they are giving lessons

The Kitsilano Figure Skating Club provides Skate Canada certified coaches to administer CanSkate, the learn-to-skate program, which starts with beginners aged 4 through adult, and progresses through 7 badge levels.

The Junior Development program is a bridge between Canskate and the Star-Skate program. While Canskate emphasizes "learn-to-skate", Junior Development skaters will work in smaller groups with a professional coach and learn figure skating skills such as jumps, edges, spirals and spins, turns and dance.

Junior Development
Program Schedule**

September 6 - March 31

JD is a 2 - 3 days per week program for skaters motivated to pursue figure skating. By intensive programming, skaters will progress more rapidly. Entrance is by coach recommendation/audition, and completion of Canskate Badge 5. This 28 week program runs from Sept 6, 2010 - March 31, 2011, with a break from Dec. 17, 2010 to January 3, 2011. The program consists of:

- 2 - 3 days/week on ice group lessons
- 2 - 3 days/week off ice group lessons
- 1 - 2 days/week enrichment.

Junior Development is a 2 to 3 day per week program. Choose a minimum of 2 days per week. This will ensure your progress through the program at an appropriate rate and that you can master the skills being taught.

Skaters with Canskate Badge 5, who do not desire accelerated programming, are welcome to continue in the Canskate Program.

All Parents/Guardians are responsible for their children while at the Kitsilano arena. Do not leave your children unattended.

Lessons continue through statutory holidays and Spring Break. Kits FSC is not responsible for your missed lessons.
